

A Whale of a Time Craft!

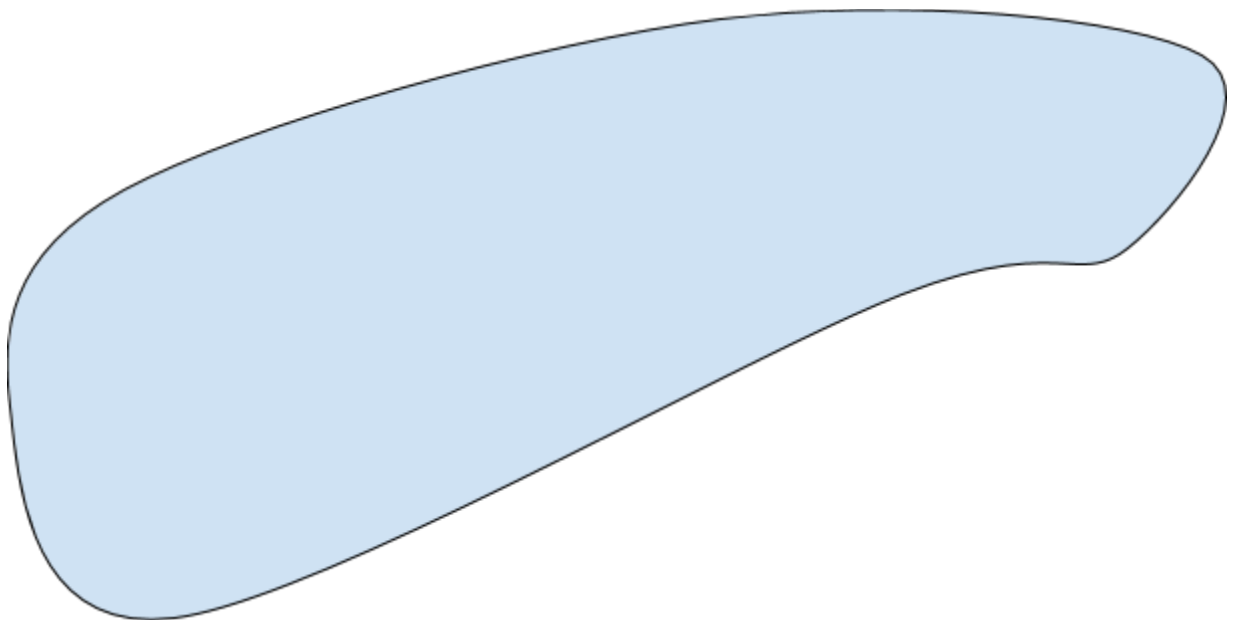
Materials:

- Blue/grey/black markers or paint
- Paper lunch bag
- Stuffing (i.e. newspaper, paper towels, etc...)
- Blue construction paper
- Elastic band
- Clear tape/glue
- Black marker

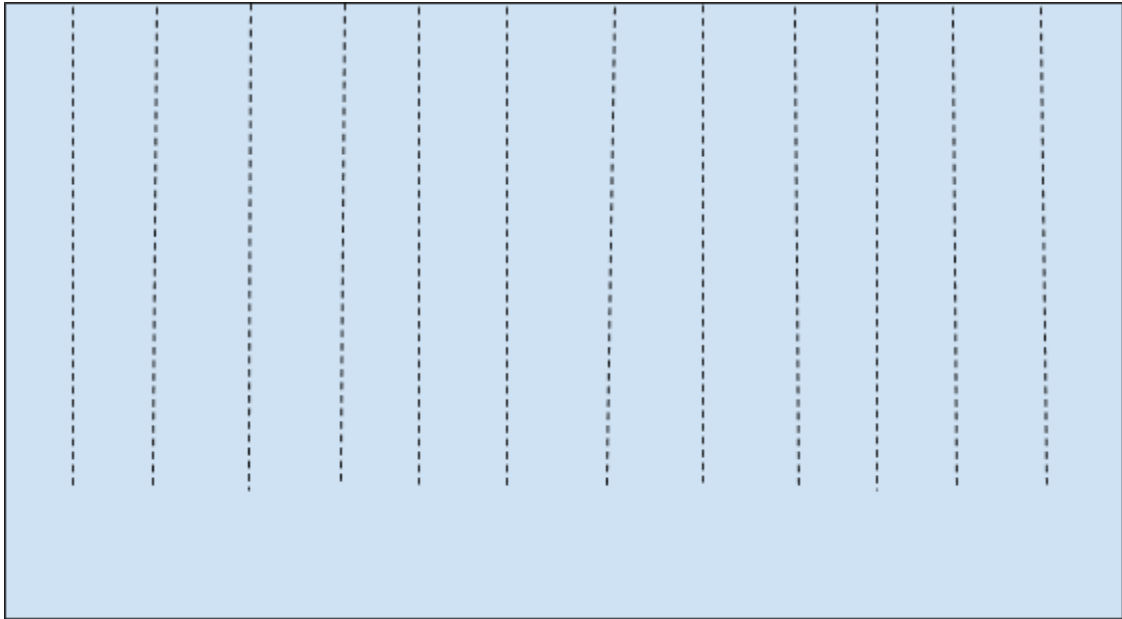


Directions:

- Crumple up the stuffing and place in the paper bag, leaving a few inches unstuffed.
- Close the paper bag by scrunching the top and wrapping the elastic band around the top so that the stuffed part of the bag looks like the body of a whale and the wrapped end is the tail.
- Color/paint the sides, top and tail of the paper bag and let it dry
- Cut out two whale flipper shapes from the construction paper



- Cut out a rectangle from the construction paper and cut slits along the dotted lines



- Roll the rectangle around a pen or pencil to make a tube and tape it closed. Bend the cut slits back to look the spout of the whale
- Once your bag is dry, tape or glue the flippers to the belly of the whale
- Poke a hole in the top of the bag, place the spout in, and tape the sides of it to the top of the bag
- Use a marker to draw the mouth and eyes on your whale
